



2021 WSRC Approved Club House Plan – COVID-19 Rules

WSRC is committed to providing a safe environment for our athletes and members. The following list with the attached plans outlines our approach to using our club house in a safe and responsible way as a result of COVID-19.

- 1) Health Screens will all be completed **prior to training and admittance to the clubhouse**. WSRC has purchased the TeamSnap App to perform and manage all health screens prior to attending any WSRC training or event. - 2) Masks will be **mandatory** at all times in the club house. These are required be non-medical masks as per the Ski Wentworth Operational Plan (ex. Buffs / scarf face coverings will not be permitted)
- 3) No food or drink will be permitted in the club house
- 4) Social distancing to be applied. The club house is 1152 sf so sufficient space to accommodate approximately 30 athletes / coaches (see attached diagram). The wall will be marked with an "x" where seating is to be located, this will allow us to control the amount of persons in the clubhouse.
- 5) One designated entrance and one designated exit will be used. *See diagram below.*
- 6) Hand sanitizing stations will be put at each entrance and exit so athletes sanitize upon entering and exiting.
- 7) Directional arrows will be put on the floor to maintain direction of travel – *See diagram below.*
- 8) No personal equipment (athletes) to be left in the club house (skis, boots, helmets etc.).
- 9) All coaching training equipment to be sanitized after use (drills, gates, spray packs etc.).
- 10) Clubhouse to be cleaned & sanitized at end of day in use.
- 11) The intended use of the clubhouse will be for warming and video / instruction.
