Eligibility

- All the participants must be born in the year 2005/2006 and be qualified competitive members of their <u>own</u> club. Official representatives chosen by each recognized club may participate in the Whistler Cup U14 Festival.
- Each club may participate with a maximum of 6 athletes (3 girls and 3 boys). In addition, each PSO <u>may</u> enter or name up to two provincial teams with a quota of 6 athletes (3 girls, 3 boys).
- Clubs may enter a second quota if space is available.
- The individuals on the Provincial team will not score points for their club. All the participants must be members of their own club, Provincial or National team and registered with their respective National Ski Federation and must be insured.

Entry deadline:

- Entries are to be submitted by a recognized club, PSO or NSO by no later than March 15, 2019 by 5pm (PST time). Entries from individuals will not be accepted. Entries should include the following:
 - The participant's name and year of birth.
 - Names of coaching staff who will be attending.
 - All area pass numbers for athletes and coaches (if applicable).
 - Please email the attached athlete's bio along with the jacket order.
 - Entries are accepted on a first come, first serve basis.
 - ONLY ONE DESIGNATED PERSON PER PROVINCE/CLUB RESPONSIBLE FOR ENTRY / SEEDING AND PAYMENT.

Fees

- The entry fee is \$515 for athletes and \$395 for coaches, before March 15, 2019. Entries received after March 15, 2019 will be \$565 for athletes, \$445 for coaches.
- Clubs may hold their team spots without athlete names to avoid late fees. Teams must be confirmed March 31, 2019 to avoid a \$50 change fee. This includes coaching staff.
- There is a \$50 cancellation fee for teams cancelling within 14 days of the event.
- There is a \$50 bib loss charge for all lost bibs.
- Payments must be made online at wmsc.info/payments once entries open November 15.

The payment includes:

- 4-day lift ticket (valid April 11-14)
- A meal package including all breakfasts at the Roundhouse Lodge and bag lunches from Friday April 12, 2019 through Sunday April 14, 2019 (Thursday meal plan (breakfast and lunch) can be purchased for additional cost TBD).
